Travel by public transport

- You can get to Tapnell Manor by boat or ferry.
- The nearest port is Yarmouth. The port is 4.4 miles / 7.1 km from Tapnell Manor.
- There are other ferry ports that you can come to by either car, these are Fishbourne (Wightlink), East Cowes (Red Funnel) or foot passengers, Ryde Pier Head, (Wightlink) or Cowes (Red Funnel/ Red Jet)
- Daily from 29th March to 28th September 2024, you can now catch the bus to Tapnell Farm from Newport Bus Station (Stand B) or Yarmouth (Stand C). The bus stop at Tapnell Farm is a 5-minute walk away from the Domes.



Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 1193mm wide, or more.
- The path to the Manor is gravel. The manor has its own car park. The track leading to the manor is a mixture of concrete and gravel.

Path to the main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 889mm wide, or more.



Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 1193mm wide.
- The main door is side-hung and manual.
- We try our best to welcome you on your arrival, depending on arrival times.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, bedside lamps, and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- Some TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- Some bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- All our bedding is non-allergenic, microfibre
- The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 12 steps.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- Some showers have a seat.
- Some showers have a handrail.
- We have bathrooms with a bath and overhead shower. The shower has a handrail.
- We have bathrooms with a bath.

- From the main entrance to the area, there are 2 steps.
- There are a few outdoor areas that guests can enjoy but they do have steps. You can access the outside areas from the games room and also from a door that leads from the main hallway.
