 - £15.69 per hour including 12.07% rolled-up holiday pay
 - Holiday entitlement is paid monthly at 12.07% in addition to the basic hourly rate.
- **Accommodation:**
 - Optional accommodation is available at an agreed monthly cost.

The role

As Aquapark Supervisor, you'll play a key role in the day-to-day running of the Aquapark, leading by example to ensure guests have a **safe, unforgettable experience** on the water.

You'll typically work **around 40 hours per week over 5 days**, though:

- School holidays may require **up to 6 days per week**
- Quieter term times may be **around 4 days per week**

No two days are the same – expect variety, responsibility, teamwork, and plenty of fresh air!

You'll need to be:

- Experienced in working at an aqua park
- A confident and capable **First Aider**
- Be **RLSS Open Water Lifeguard qualified**
OR meet the course pre-requisites and be willing to undertake training

RLSS OWL pre-requisites include:

- Minimum age: **16**
- Ability to swim **400 metres continuously** with a degree of urgency

- A positive, well-organised **natural leader**
- Calm and effective under pressure in busy environments
- A strong team player who leads with energy and enthusiasm

Bonus points if you're also:

- Comfortable completing basic administrative tasks
 - Passionate about working with **young people and school groups**
 - Experienced in working with or leading **school residentials or groups**
