Travel by public transport

- You can get to Wendy House by boat or ferry.
- The nearest port is Yarmouth. The port is 3.6 miles / 5.8 km from Wendy House.
- Lymington to Yarmouth is the closest ferry terminal however there is also the option of Portsmouth- Fishbourne or Southampton to East Cowes via car ferry. Foot passenger options also include: Southsea- Ryde Hovertravel, Southampton- West Cowes Red Jet

🖨 Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with ICab by calling 07553 567567. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- You can get a taxi with Bay Taxi by calling 07475662350.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The area for parking is right outside the house in a large private driveway area

From the street to the main entrance, there is 1 step. There is no ramp and no lift.

Main entrance

- The door is 750mm wide.
- The main entrance has 1 steps.
- The main door is side hung and manual.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights and bedside lamps.
- Lights are LED. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- The kitchen and living room has a tiled floor to avoid dust collection. All bedding is non-allergenic. We can give details of our cleaning products on request.
- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the front only.

E Self catering kitchen

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there are 13 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The work surface is available with clear underspace.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- Table wood, plates white

Lounge

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there are 13 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The lounge is upstairs as the Wendy House is an upside down house

Getting around outside

- From the main entrance to the gardens, there is 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The garden can be accessed from the side of the house and also from the bedrooms
